**School Inspection**: A written report on the Curriculum Evaluation of Science carried out by Cigire Niamh Quinn from the Department of Education & Skills on Tuesday, 22<sup>nd</sup> January, can now be viewed on the Department of Education & Skill's website, <a href="www.education.ie">www.education.ie</a>. We are pleased that it reports positively on the quality of pupils' learning in Science, the quality of their learning experiences and the high quality of teachers' practice evident in our school, in progressing pupils' learning.

Junior Achievement: This programme recently ran in the senior classroom for 40 minutes weekly for five weeks. It was co-ordinated by Adriana from Combilift, Monaghan and explored areas such as business ownership, producing a product using different methods of production, looking at the costs associated with running a business, taking charge of their own businesses to make a profit! A school visit into Combilift on June 18<sup>th</sup> will be the final step of this programme. Indeed, we hope the whole experience will inspire 'entrepreneurship' thinking into the future!





**FAI Soccer Blitz:** Another sporting performance by our boys in the soccer blitz, organised by the FAI, which took place, on Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> April 2019, at the pitch of Monaghan Utd FC, Gortakeegan, Monaghan.
