#### Dear Parents,

Garda Vetting Requirements: Thank you to the parents who sent in their completed Garda application vetting forms. I would ask that any other parent who still wishes to be involved in any future school activity with the children e.g. school tour, to return his/her vetting form as soon as possible.

As per statutory requirements of the 'Child Protection Procedures for Primary and Post-Primary Schools 2017', Garda vetting is **compulsory** for any person, who may be in contact with the children in our care, when assisting, in a parental capacity, in any school activity.





### February 23<sup>rd</sup> 2018

**Road Safety Authority:** A representative of the Road Safety Authority will visit the school tomorrow, Friday 23<sup>rd</sup>, to deliver a programme aimed at promoting an understanding of road safety.
